101/17 Matters Arising/ Unresolved Issues

The Shropshire Council Road Safety Policy allows for five sites of concern to be reported to the Highways Department twice yearly. The Clerk is to identify key criteria from what is a large policy document, to enable councillors to prepare a response.

The results of the data recently gathered by Shropshire Council speed recording equipment in Station Road, Cressage, were presented to the meeting. Average speeds recorded were far less than the perceptions of tresidents, at an average of 28.9 mph approaching Cressage, 27.7 leaving Cressage.

These would not indicate the financial viability of the purchase of speed prevention equipment. The residents are to be informed.
